#### 1. System Requirements

- CPU IBM, Pentium or compatible PC
- Memory 16 M Byte
- System Microsoft® Windows® 98/ME/2000
- Graphic Adaptor VGA

### 2. USB Driver Installation

- a. Copy entire **<USB Driver>** folder from CD to hard disk.
- b. Connect AQ-300 USB connector to computer. Computer will detect the new device, then starts the installation program, please direct the driver to the **<USB Driver>** folder for driver.

c. After the installation is complete, go to <Device Manager> and select <Ports (COM & LPT) > to verify if a virtual COM port <USB to Serial Port> was created.

#### 3. After Installation

Verify the COM port # to start using your own navigating software.

a. Click <Start> menu, select <Settings>, then enter <Control Panel>.



b. After entering <Control Panel>, select <System>.



c. Select <Device Manager>, find the <Universal Serial Bus Controller> and check the Virtual COM Port, which was created by the USB driver, i.e. USB to Serial Port (COM #).
 Please note that the Virtual COM Port number might be different from every computer.



**Note!!** Before using *navigation software*, please confirm the COM Port numbers created by your computer and provided by your navigation software. Otherwise, the navigating software won't receive the satellite signal, because of the un-match COM Port setting.
